

Additional Job Information

First Aid	Individuals to man the First Aid Tents throughout the Tennis, Golf, Trap Shoot, and Run events. Assignments are about three hours in duration. Trap shoot will be a four-hour assignment. Each tent will have a minimum of two volunteers. One volunteer will need to have some clinical experience. No experience required for the second volunteer. Please note on the front of this form if you have medical experience.
SWAT Team	To assist with set-up and tear down of events, loading and unloading food and prizes, and other manual tasks. Need volunteers all day on days indicated but you can work limited hours.
Run	These volunteers will help conduct the 10K/5K Run and 1- mile Walk located at Arvest Ballpark, Springdale AR (home of The Naturals). Jobs include registration, refreshment distribution, water stations, and other miscellaneous jobs that will be assigned upon arrival. Will work a maximum of four hours on Saturday morning beginning at 6:30am.
Golf	Golf has two unique jobs, each about six hours in duration. Having your own cart for these jobs is appreciated but is not absolutely necessary. Hole-in-One: On holes designated as part of the Golf Game Package, volunteers will be needed to explain rules and/or to validate winners. Rover: Two people in a golf cart will drive to holes designated as having Golf Games to provide relief to the volunteers assigned to that hole.
Refreshments	Volunteers to distribute refreshments to participants at the golf and trap shoot events.
Participant Bags	Fill bags with various items that will be given to tournament participants. There will be two, three-hour shifts. Shifts are: 8-11am and 11am -2pm. The first shift will set up and the last two will fill the bags.
Golf Registration	Two-hour assignment to get golfers checked in for play on Friday, both morning and afternoon. Shifts are 6-8am and 11am-1:30pm. Will also hand out participant bags, shirts, and hats.
Trap Shoot	Half day assignments to perform the following functions: registration/cashier, food & beverage distribution, and other miscellaneous assignments.
Prizes	To distribute golf prizes and banners to corporate teams following the event. Will need to be familiar with NWA and have own car.
Decorations	Volunteers to help decorate the John Q. Hammons Convention Center for the Social & Auction (Friday)
Golf Bag Drop	Greet golfers, provide hole assignments, and direct them to their cart. Players will be responsible for transporting their own bags.
Auction Set-up	Need individuals to help with the set-up of merchandise during the day. This includes the assembly of merchandise as well as the display and/or presentation on the tables.
Auction Operations	Need individuals to monitor auction tables and answer questions for the bidders. This job does require volunteers to stand for extended periods of time. Some volunteers will greet and register guests. This is about a five-hour assignment beginning at 5:30pm. Also need volunteers to help with merchandise at the close of the auction and the next morning for pick-up of items.
Cashiers	Cashiers are needed for Golf, Motorcycle, and the Auction. Please specify event if you have a preference. Familiarity with manual and electronic credit card machines would be helpful.
Signing	To inventory and setup signs and banners at various events.
